The paper is well-written and coherently argued. The general argument is plausible. The review of relevant literature is comprehensive.

However, there is an important gap that needs to be filled before the paper can be published. The author ignores the famous paper by Charles Sanders Peirce "Hume on Miracles" of c. 1901, available in Peirce's Collected Papers, §§ 6.522-6.547 and the literature concerning Peirce's argument, e.g.
