Theoretical framework: The paper could enhance its clarity by providing a more defined theoretical background, particularly in defining a key concept like "effective communication," which is essential for understanding the study. I also suggest more recent sources and a stronger framework.

Methodologically, there's room for improvement in the paper's clarity regarding data collection techniques. While the study adopts a qualitative approach, which is appropriate, it would benefit from at least indicating the unit of analysis for clarity. Including data on the sample size, interviews, observations, and analyzed documents in the methodology section would improve clarity. Additional detail is necessary concerning the researcher's role and the ethical considerations involved in the study.

Findings: The data provides valuable insights, but incorporating supporting statements or quotes could enrich the empirical findings of the study. More detailed results would be meaningful.
