- It is too long and a little boring, both for reviewer and maybe the next reader. I think it should be summarized, including its "ABSTRACT" section.
- More explanation is necessary in the "METHOD" section, for instance, if the PRISMA guidelines have been followed or not?
- the limitations of this study should be more explained, since the other people (in the other countries) are not familiar
 with health issues in China especially in the target group, and the problems or limitations against the implementation of
 this study.
