

Review of: "An exploration of undergraduate university students' motivations for engagement in pre-drinking and drinking games in Singapore and Europe"

The paper explores undergraduate university students' motivations for engagement in pre-drinking and drinking games in Singapore and Europe. It presents results from a multi-country online survey and shows that pre-drinking and drinking game playing are interlinked as socializing patterns in peer groups and activities among students. This is a very well written paper that clearly presents the results and discusses the main findings of the study.

My recommendation relates to the mentioned use of a mixed methods approach involving quantitative and qualitative methodology. It should be specified that only the quantitative part of the mixed methods study will be presented in the paper.

It is interesting also to describe how the qualitative study was conducted as part of the presentation of the overall project (in the beginning of the paper).
