I had one question regarding the source of feeding for these infants. During the first 4-6 months of life do the authors feel that the source of feeding from either breast feeding or formula feeding is important. Do we know how the infants in the study were fed? Do the authors feel that iron supplementation especially in breast fed infants is important as well.
