Minor vocabulary corrections are necessary: to treat an infection, we use antibiotic therapy, not pharmacotherapy.

There are other cases in the text.

## Major corrections are mandatory:

- . *Outline*. Sub-chapters and summary tables are missing to make reading easier.
- . *The clinical trials* are not graded (1A,1B,1C,2A,2B,2C). This means that no recommendations can be drawn from them.
- . *The usual pressures* of use are not specified, nor the number of cuffs, nor the limb segments treated, nor the recommended protocols for use.

In conclusion, a summary article that needs to be reworked to achieve its didactic goal.
