Section	Comments
General comment	This manuscript is worth publishing, subject to minor corrections. The abstract should, however, be re-written to reflect and cover the entire body of the document.
Specific comments per section	
Abstract	The abstract contains information that should be in the introduction. The information currently given should be summarized in, say, a maximum of 2 sentences, then dwell more on methodology, results, discussion, conclusion, and recommendations. It is advisable to be specific in the last sentence and state the recommendations in summary instead of saying that the paper presents recommendations.
Introduction	The introduction is quite well written, with clear information that guides the readers on the subject matter.
Methodology,	The methodology is clearly written.
Review Reports of SDGs	Results of data reviews are clearly presented on a goal-by-goal basis. In Section 3.4, second last paragraph, the figures 18-37 years should be percentages.
Looking Back and Thinking Forward to 2030	The analysis of review information is clear and well presented.
Summary and conclusion	The summary and conclusion points are well presented.
Recommendations	The recommendations are clear for policy makers and other stakeholders to pick and consider implementing.
References	The reference list is well written, with a uniform format.
