Few comments I would like to make are: As mentioned in the body of the article, Long COVID is more common in those who were initially symptomatic, this can be challenged as Long COVID is being seen nearly equally even in non-symptomatic patient. This actually would make the case of the author even stronger. This of course is a single case study and it would be much better if conducted with a bigger population. Also, a more detailed explanation of the case would be better e.g. The symptom evaluation and comparison can be done using numerical scale from 0 - 10. We would get a better picture of how bad the initial condition was and how it improved during the serial injections.

The discussion section provides good analysis and future prospects for studies.

Overall, this is a lesser explored arena and definitely worth sharing with the world through publication.
