 In Table 3.3, the author(s) should write "Likert scale" in the column of the scale of measurement instead of "continuous".

- Did author(s) check the normality of data? If so report its results.
- Results are not supported by relevant literature.



- Results are also not matched with hypothesized relationships.
- The values of F statistics and R square are not reported.
