Below are some suggestions for improving the paper:

- 1) The literature review needs to be supplemented with additional extracts that will further indicate the research hypotheses and connect the study's purpose with specific research objectives.
- 2) It is necessary to further explain the method of measuring student satisfaction and performance.
- 3) To make the paper appear more academic and less like a presentation of results, it's necessary to add academic insights.
- 4) Consider incorporating the factor of the academic year to see if there are differences in satisfaction among different years of study.
- 5) Further investigate which indicators have the most influence on high academic grades.
- 6) The discussion is fine. The conclusion should be written to address each research objective. Also, add a section about the limitations of the research.
- 7) As a suggestion for future research, consider conducting a factor analysis to identify factors that can be used in further analysis.
