The theme of the article seems to me to be very interesting and important for the understanding of the new teaching-learning processes. The article is founded on a project that is called "Agile learning project". It is not known, at what stage the development of the project is. The article seems to summarise the fundamental aspects of the project.

I think the article needs to develop more about the state of the art of what the author calls agile learning. The author shows that the project is based on the interaction of three axes: agile related; digital; transverse. It would be important how this interaction works to help to build the final discussion and conclusion of this study. Since the central theme is agile learning, it seems confusing to me that one of the axes has the same name (agile related). Does the author mean the flexibility of the teaching-learning process?

The article considers some instruments/methodologies inserted in the agile learning process. There are several associated concepts in the literature, such as the use of soft skills and service learning. That is why it is important in this project to have an in-depth review of the literature on various studies in the area, their conclusions, and a better explanation of the concepts used. The project refers to teaching processes, but isn't it more important the learning processes and their interaction with the teaching process?

The article has an important bibliography, but unfortunately, the references are not mentioned in the text.

To sum up, this article seems interesting to me but is still incomplete, so I encourage it to continue.
