1. I recommend reorganizing the paper in the form of: Introduction, Literature review, Method, Results, Discussion, and Conclusion so that it is easier for the reader to understand the topic and read it clearly.
2. I recommend adding a literature review section and making it more comprehensive. It should discuss studies that addressed the same variables as the proposed paper.
3. There is not enough information about the study sample. How was it chosen? Is it representative of the population or not? Is there any potential selection bias?
4. The paper does not discuss the psychometric properties of the instruments. There is no information about the validity and reliability of the instruments.
5. The analysis of the results lacks depth and explanation of these results. What are the implications of these results? What is the scientific importance of these results? How were they linked to the results of previous studies?
6. I recommend that the authors proofread the paper because there are many mistakes.
