Thank you for sharing this important paper with me for peer review. The authors did good work, and I have some comments from my side hoping to improve the quality of the manuscript.

1. **Abstract:** Please add subheadings to the abstract (background, objectives, method, results, conclusion) to make it easier for readers to get the information.
2. The first paragraph seems to be the authors' opinion as it does not have a reference. Usually, in the introduction, authors represent what others wrote, and their opinion should come in the sections of results and discussion.
3. In the second paragraph, authors mentioned that "a recent study looked at mental health disorders and suicidality of young people.....). The reference of this statement dates to 2021, which cannot be considered as recent.
4. There is an abbreviation that was not mentioned in full before being used in the text as PTSD on page four.
