Thank you for sharing this paper. It's not my area of expertise, but it was interesting. You cover a lot of topics, from issues with academic jargon to how AI can make learning easier. That's a good thing, but it also makes the paper feel scattered. The writing style felt more like a personal reflection than a focused academic paper. If you could make your points more clearly and directly, that would help. Maybe you could use some diagrams to make your ideas easier to understand.

You also talk about the problems with the peer-review process in academia. That's an important topic, but you don't suggest any real solutions, which makes that part feel incomplete. Finally, the paper ends abruptly. A conclusion usually wraps things up and summarizes the main points, but yours just felt like another regular paragraph. Overall, I think you have something here, but it needs more focus and a clearer structure and should be condensed down.
