The manuscript entitled "A Research Note on Natural Reclamation Processes that Support Mangrove Biodiversity Spheres: Sedimentation in Three Major River Deltas in North Western Luzon Using Aerial Imagery" is fascinating; however, it has lot many gaps. The manuscript should be revised entirely before publication. The detailed report is given below.

- 1. The abstract of the manuscript needs to be completed and longer, requiring modification with some quantitative findings of the study.
- 2. Some unnecessary keywords to be omitted.
- 3. The introduction needs to be better written and required more content about the literature, covering the regional and global perspectives.
- 4. The methodology needs to be written properly and needs clarity with a proper flowchart mentioning the data used and techniques through which results have been obtained.
- 5. The result is not written as it should be written on paper. Need to rewrite it.
- 6. The author could modify the figures, as the map needs to be revised to the standard of an article. All the figures to be reproduced keeping similar font sizes of latitude, longitude, Scale and North arrow. There is no similarity in maintaining lat/long.
- 7. Overall, the manuscript needs to restructure, and the results must be quantified and verified.
