Regarding the article's structure, there is a clear presentation of the findings, supported by figures that enhance understanding. However, a more extensive discussion section is suggested, allowing for a deeper exploration of the theoretical and practical implications of the results. Likewise, it would be valuable to address the study's limitations and propose possible directions for future research, enhancing the findings' relevance and applicability.

This article offers valuable contributions and practical recommendations for social work professionals interested in promoting sustainable community development. However, a more explicit and detailed description of the methodology used is suggested, as well as an expansion in the discussion section and consideration of potential study limitations. These adjustments would strengthen the academic robustness and applicability of the presented results.
