The review is thorough and well written. The narration is smooth for the reader. I believe however that the surgical management of diabetic retinopathy part chould be left outside the manuscript as it represents a condition with a different pathophysiology, treatment options and prognosis to the vitreous floaters.

My recommendation would be to focus on the differential diagnosis of vitreous floaters and analyze further treatment options and outcomes of those related with vitreous syneresis and posterior vitreous detachment (eg cataract progression is not reported as a complication of vitrectomy for vitreous floaters - there are grading methods developed for the grading of vitreous floaters using infrared imaging that should be reported)
