I see that you have improved some aspects of your document and made it fit a little more with the Prisma Declaration. It is important that you continue working in this sense. As you know, this version of the statement was created to access more transparency. In the document, it is still missing:

- Flowchart of the article selection process.
- Table with all the articles that were used in this review.

It is important that you follow the structure determined by Prisma 2020. In the methods area, it is missing to include which methodology was followed to analyze the bias, and in the analysis area, to show the results of this bias analysis.

Remember that abstracts are written in a single paragraph. In Cochrane, you can find information related to the methods that allow the evaluation of biases.

On this occasion, I will not make any comments related to the content because I consider that it could be enriched by introducing these changes. As some colleagues have commented, the topic is interesting. Seeing the evolution from one paper to the other, I see that you can reach a good conclusion, but I strongly recommend keeping working on the structure of the paper and on the methodology.
