**Definition:** A plant of the species that belongs to the Nicotiana genus of herbaceous plants.

**Comment:** Nicotiana species include many varieties. These are commonly referred to as tobacco plants, and are cultivated as ornamental garden plants. N. tabacum is grown worldwide for production tobacco-containing products.

**Curator note:** Although there are definitions of tobacco plant in other ontologies, these were not quite suitable for the purposes of AddictO.

Ontological definitions can sometimes be hard to read. In those cases we also include an informal definition.

Definitions also often require elaboration to make it clear how they should be used and what they include. In those cases we include a comment.

Also, definitions sometimes require an explanation as to how they came about to help users understand how they relate to alternative definitions. In those cases we include a curator note.
