However, there are some aspects that need to be improved in order for this article to make a real contribution to the scientific literature.

## 1. The title

The content of the article would require that the title be revised to read "Improving agriculture and food security in Africa: One health approach perspective".

## 2. The abstract

It does not sufficiently highlight the problems associated with sustainable agriculture in sub-Saharan Africa and the extent of food insecurity in this region shaken by terrorism, which leads to massive displacement of people who can no longer sustainably farm. The issues related to these aspects must be highlighted.

## 3. Introduction

Although well structured and well written, there is no abstract on national policies for sustainable agriculture and One Health policies although table 1 has provided initiatives by country or organisation.

4. Table 2. Strategies to facilitate the One Health approach in African agriculture. It would be appropriate to provide these strategies by African country and perhaps explore their limitations in the African context.
