2. There are multiple grammatical mistakes including problems in sentence construction and conveying the proper message. The manuscript needs to be assessed by a language expert.

3. Results need to be elaborated with special attention to statistical analysis.

4. Number of references are too less and most of the cited references are relatively on older age.

Overall this article needs major revision and it not fit for the publication unless revised and rewritten.
