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The text proposes to do something very important, which is a kind of evaluation of health care services for drug users. It is quite clear how data collection was organized. However, it is not clear in the article, what is the theoretical foundation regarding and what it would mean by "creative art". Is it just about fine arts? Or if there is any therapeutic proposal behind it? It is not clear in the text whether the conclusions point in a positive or negative way in relation to what was evaluated and it is not clear what exactly the authors set out to evaluate. There is a lack of theoretical foundations about why the evaluation is carried out and how the evaluation results guide us.
