The manuscript is relevant for the IA2030 and most especially post COVID-19 period. Some errors have been noted in the write up for instance under results sections the gendar segregation needs to be looked at again to clear state the proportion of males and females. Secondly the write up should be clear how the 118 children were allocated either one per parent /caretaker or any child aged between 1 and 5 year in a particular household was sampled. Table 1 shows good results but it would be great to include comparison between fully vaccinated and partially vaccinated to enable the reader interprete the final results. Minimise the text before the table probably a summary may be better so that there is no need of mentioning each and every item in the table. Thirdly the definition of complete vaccination was missed in the write up; the inclusion and exclusion criteria is rather confusing this needs to be rewritten. Finally i believe the grammatic issues will also be looked at in the entire manuscript
