I do not have any major reservations, few minor points:

- 1) It is rather unusual to cite a textbook as a seminal ("some of the greatest") contribution to any discipline. I am referring to the "A primer in game theory" by Robert Gibbons.
- 2) Consistency is missing in the references' list. Remove the errors (Gibbons et. al) and give the full information for the citations used.
- 3) Do not take for granted that the general reader is familiar with the differences between advantageous inequality and disadvantageous inequality and why  $\alpha i > \beta i$ .
