While I appreciate your article and the direction you take it, there is an important alternative interpretation that you're leaving out. I will explain it in more detail.

Our observation is that dreams, more than anything else, are conduits for our unresolved unconscious past experiences to find alternative ways of being completed and resolved. They are like open cycles that are seeking to close through either dreaming or conscious processing that can lead to catharsis. The more we consciously resolve, the more this reduces the amount of processing that takes place through dreaming.
