

Review of: "Severe Cutaneous Adverse Drugs Reactions: From Causes To Mechanisms"

The paper by Morgillo and colleagues give us a focus on the severe adverse drug reaction starting from the causes and moving to the mechanisms.

The purpose is partially achieved: the paper is well written but it would be more completed if the authors gave more information on the pathological pathways involved in the adverse drug reaction. For example: make a difference between suspected mechanisms beyond the reaction due to antibiotics (ADR to piperacillin tazobactam is poorly described in literature despite its wide use, sometimes improper use) and due to antiepileptics.

In general, if authors could add aforementioned points, the manuscript would be suitable for publication.
