This article summarizes a series of key techniques in Computer-enhanced Education, such as Soft Computing, AI, Social robots, and genetic algorithms. From my point of view, it is more like a survey, rather than a scientific paper. The article is readable but requires efforts to improve its quality. My comments are listed below.

- 1. It would be better to add future research directions for Al-based Education. Also, can authors add their own experiences or case studies in this field?
- 2. Please clarify the logic of the three sections, i.e., Sec. 2-4.
- 3. There are typos even in Abstract: "Thepaper", "isinvestigated", "e-learningwith", "Computingin". In Introduction, "before the A"--> "before the AI"; In Sec. 3, "an AAN" --> "an ANN". I cannot enumerate them all, so please carefully revise the article.
- 4. There are too many (up to 13) keywords. Please keep around 5-7 keywords.
- 5. Please break the long sentences into several short ones to improve the readability.
- 6. The references are a little bit old, as most of them are before 2020.
