It is a very complete and interesting text, it addresses the topic with an adequate context of the theory used to analyze the situation.

Here are some suggestions that I think could improve the understanding of the article and give it greater benefit:

- 1.- The summary could include some main findings, in order to present in detail the purpose of the research.
- 2.- The introduction could include the reason and need to study the discontinuity of cities. What are the positive and negative impacts of discontinuities? How does this affect citizens?
- 3.- Within the review of the three axes of the theory analyzed, it would be good to add at the end a text that mixes or relates the theories, in order to understand why the discontinuities are analyzed from these three points of view. It would also be good to add a summary image of the three axes in which discontinuities are addressed.
- 4.- Within the explanation of linguistic, philosophical and mathematical discontinuities, practical examples applied to urban design and planning could be included.
- 5.- I feel that there is a lack of further depth in the discussion, that is, comparisons could be included with a greater number of studies that are related to urban planning and design.
- 6.- In summary I consider it to be a very complete article, congratulations to the author.
