

Review of: "Studying the Level of Livelihood Vulnerability and the Necessity of the Work Developing a Farmhouse Economic Economic Model to Adapt to Climate Change in the Coastal Area of Ben Tre"

The article is a good addition to the livelihood vulnerability due to climate change in the study area. I observed the following shortcomings in the article.

- 1. The title of the article should be concise and review.
- 2. Research methodology needs to improve. What kind of questionnaire did you use? It should be clear for the reader. It is well structured, semi-structured, etc.
- 3. The population is very low; you will interview only 80 households. The population size should be 5% of the total population of the study area to justify the results.
- 4. In the results and discussions, table 3.1 should be reviewed. The table 3.3 is not clear regarding the values 1, 2, 3, etc. What do they mean? The table 3.4 states that the total population size was 80, which does not match your table values. It should be reviewed carefully.
- 5. In heading 4, Livelihood Model, you evaluated different parameters at different levels with symbols T, K, and TB and wrote T for good and K for good. What do you want to say?
- The article lacks references in the discussion, and you did not reveal this study to anyone. You should correlate your study with latest references, and it should be reflected in your discussion. The literature cited is outdated and very short. It should be increased.
- 7. The author did not use any statistical tools in the study. It used simple statistics (frequency %) in one table, 3.4.
- 8. I suggested that it is a good study but needs improvements mentioned in the review.
