This article is very interesting and provides a lot of important information. To improve the quality so reviewer provides the following suggestions:

1. Abstract: It is recommended that the abstract introduction state the urgency of the problem to be researched and why it must be researched.
2. Introduction: Explain why you chose secondary school? why not at other levels of education? what's the problem at that level?; Why are you interested in researching only educators? and why it should be at the locus? provide an overview of the problems that exist at the locus so that you choose to be the research location.; Also clearly explain the scope of your research.
3. Methodology
  - a. Even though in your abstract you have provided a brief explanation of the method, it is suggested that in the method chapter you can explain in more detail regarding the research design you are using.
  - b. Explained in more detail, who are the respondents or your research sample? How many people? How do you choose them? Why do you choose them?
  - c. Write in detail the research steps you carried out including the instruments used at each stage of your research.
  - d. Because your research respondents are human, explain the application of research ethics that you have implemented, has it been reviewed by an ethics committee?
4. Conclusion:
  - a. Conclusions are suggested to be able to answer the research objectives directly to provide a clear understanding to the readers.
  - b. It is highly recommended that the conclusion chapter also explain the benefits of this research for science and society, as well as practical recommendations that can be carried out by relevant stakeholders.
