CD45RA is encoded by the human PTPRC gene. This protein plays a role in both lymphocyte function and protein dephosphorylation. It is an isoform of receptor-type tyrosine-protein phosphatase C that is missing the amino acids encoded by exons 5 and 6 of the PTPRC gene.
