- The theoretical foundation is too extensive and general. I recommend you reduce it and specify and contextualize the main aspects related to this investigation.
- The methodological design is not specified and neither is the process of designing the questionnaire (if the questionnaire has been validated and in what way)
- The sample must be reflected by a number and be described through its sociodemographic characteristics (these are not research results)
- It is recommended to add an inferential analysis to increase the quality of the article
- Finally, it would be interesting to highlight the usefulness and contribution of this research to society and more specifically to the educational field.
