- b. Abstract needs to be revised. Abstract contents: problems, objectives, methods (design, samples, instruments, data analysis), results, and conclusions. What research method do you want to use? literature study (library research) or case study or phenomenon study?

Introduction

- 2. Does the introduction provide background and information relevant to the study?
- a. ...encouraging healing process, and drive societal and psychological changes within Albania (in the last paragraph of the introduction). My question as a reader: What healing process do Albanians experience? Physical or Psychological Injury? To this day, are there still Albanian people suffering from post-communist psychological pain? If there is, please add the literature in the introduction.
- b. Use the latest study literature, at least the last 5 years.

3. How important should this research be? Are there any particular cases that researchers are interested in conducting this research?

Methods

- 4. Are the methods clear and replicable? Do all the results presented match the methods described?
- a. What research method do you want to use? literature study (library research) or case study or phenomenon study?



- b. How are respondents selected for this research?
- c. 70.3 years, with the majority of participants being female, representing 55% of the sample. What is the actual number of respondents who participated in this research? 50 people or 100 people for example.

Results

- 5. The research results must answer the research questions. Sort the answers according to the research question.
- 6. The researcher has not described the results for question number three in the results section: What are today's implications of existential collective guilt and meaning-making for well-being and reconciliation in post-communist Albania?

Discussion

7. Research discussion must discuss research result.

Conclusion

8. There are no issues with the research conclusions. Conclusion looks OK.

- 9. References must be updated with the latest references, no later than the last 5 years for research articles.
- 10. The number of research references directly related to research material is still lacking.
