The paper deals with a relevant topic in the current training of young university students: development of generic competencies. However, there is some room for improvement in the study.

- 1) The bibliographical references could be more updated. Ideally from the last 5 years.
- 2) The paper seeks to contribute to "understand the influence of Generic Competencies in the students' learning process as future citizens and professionals for the globalized world, through the formulation of theoretical-practical guidelines for its development" This is not detailed in the discussion or in the conclusions. Incorporating this theme would help to understand the contribution of the paper. Perhaps it could be better explained how the importance and level of development of generic competencies contribute to this contribution.
- 3) It would be good to have a characterization of the sample of 324 students analyzed and to see if there is a significant difference between the averages of the study and the data of Latin American students. Perhaps also justify this comparison.
- 4) In general, the discussion of the results could be further expanded.
- 5) In the conclusions include the implications of the results and the limitations of the study.
