The paper shows an interesting revision of the publications of Canada in 2023, but I would need more information in order to better understand the scope and the level of Canadian research.

- It would be interesting to indicate the absolute data with the percentage of the total because it helps to compare. In general, no percentages are indicated in the information provided.
- There are no university indicators (budgets, number of researchers, ...) to know if those who publish more do so because they have more resources (human and technical).
- Are the authors who publish the most from the same university or research group?
- It would be useful to include a map with the distribution and location of the universities to know in which part of the country or which cities the institutions with the highest publication rates are concentrated.
- It would be necessary to indicate the authors' H-index and analyze the results.

In my opinion, the article needs further work before publication.
