I find the work done very interesting. You have a representative sample from which some relationships can be extrapolated. You should not only limit yourself to the statistical description, but you can carry out a more rigorous analysis. For example, obtain the characteristics of women who are mothers and have higher education, or only analyze the women who have more experience in the business; that is, only analyze the businesses that are more than 6 years old and see their characteristics. The literature already presents differences between companies that are in the startup stage and more stable companies; in this case, your contribution would be on that side, in determining the characteristics of companies established for more than three years that continue in business.

I also recommend focusing the literature on the study objective that may be more interesting to publish than analyzing certain sectors for which there is no evidence, such as companies that have been in the market for more than three years and are led by women.
