

Review of: "[Commentary] Commentary on Sociocultural Beliefs and Systems Restricting Women's Access to their Marital Property Rights in Pakistan"

This article provides important insight into the hindrances being created by sociocultural beliefs for Pakistani women to acquire marital property. The themes of discussion are illustrated very well. However, I suggest as follows.

- In the very inception of this article, it is mentioned that the Constitution of Pakistan, 1973 protects women to acquire marital rights; but no article of the constitution related to this protection is mentioned. It would be more elaborate and understandable, if a few articles of the constitution of Pakistan, 1973 about the topic be mentioned.
- The argument based on earlier research has been established very well but no example from Pakistani society is provided. It is suggested that a few examples from Pakistani society be related to the previous work.
- A brief conclusion of the discussion on the topic is suggested to be included at the end of this article.
- Though it is a commentary, if possible the technique or method should be mentioned. This mentioning of the research method, in my opinion, will further enhance the validity of this article.
