- 3. <u>Abstract:</u> Strong abstract. Everything is connected, there is all the information needed, and the english is good. I have nothing noteworthy to say about this.
- 4. Review: Solid information, It's simple, a mini-review, but it feels incomplete We need more about the theme. Furthermore, it's well organized with several titles and subtitles according to the information given. However, and this is a major point, there is many expressions with slang language for example: Page 2: "Maybe not flavors, but you get the point" or "Not today, antibiotics!"; Page 3: "It's like giving the bouncer a pair of handcuffs, making it impossible for them to kick anyone out."
