

## Review of: "The two sides of Experienced Crisis: Enabling and preventing Coping strategies during Covid-19 Pandemic"

A well written manuscript, dealing with the strategies that people employed in order to confront the different and unknown experiences of Covid-19 crisis.

46 in-depth interviews with Greek participants, during the April 2020 first lockdown, residing in 23 cities worldwide have been analysed.

Very interesting results have appeared from the analysis.

However, there is no analysis about the connection between the experiences and the feelings of the participants from the crisis with the age of participants, the sex of the participants or the type of their employment.
