In the introduction it is not clear what the objectives of the paper and the academic value of the research are, it only superficially includes many topics that do not lead to a clear example of the novelty of the paper.

The conceptual framework just concludes what is the central theory and its derivations on which the paper is based. I consider it important to show the conclusions cited as "this review extends to other complementary contributions, such as the case studies of Grice-Hutchinson (1976) and the modelling of Machlup (1954) and Garrison (2001)" and the treatment in a summary table, since it might perhaps uncover some relationship to the researcher's objective.

I think he should not support the paper so much on his own research, see references (Sánchez-Bayón, 2020a-b & 2021b; Sánchez-Bayón & Trincado, 2020).

On the basis of the above, I consider that a further revision should be made in order to denote more clearly what is the best contribution of the work submitted for evaluation.
