Review of: "Kienböck's Disease May Be Due to a Wrist-Joint Tamponade"

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This is an interesting manuscript about the etiology of Kienböck's disease, and I recommend acceptance without revisions.

It is a summary of interesting citations supporting the hypothesis of increased pressure leading to Kienboeck's disease. The idea to recommend arthrocentesis is good; however, it might be combined with imaging, mainly MRI. From my personal experience as a radiologist, in the rare cases of Kienboeck's disease, there was no intraarticular effusion visible in any of these cases. Maybe the authors could check the literature with respect to the imaging findings of effusion in Kienboeck's disease.
