The **abstract** is very detailed; I like that, but several points could be more connected.

The introduction lacks references.

Review of literature is very good and deep work!

I would suggest splitting 'Results" and 'Discussion" so that the reader clearly knows what is fact and what is interpretation.

In my opinion, there is no need to list all the different education models in detail - it does not make sense in this case...

Figure 1 has bad quality and is too large.

Figure 2 is way too large!

Conclusion is very short compared to the other sections.
