- 3. The number of Nutritionists or Dietician included in the study is very low as compare to nurses and other medical professionals.
- 4. The introduction is not systematic and vague, it is highlighting the role of nutrition education instead of need of imparting nutrition education in proper manner to the patients.
- 5. The study does not assess how nutrition knowledge is imparted.
- 6. The mode of measurement of competence of health care giver need to be added.
- 7. The author need to relate the results with the review of literature in more systematic manner and with more current studies.
