Review of: "The Study of Consciousness Is Mired in Complexities and Difficulties: Can They Be Resolved?"

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The new version 3 clarifies some issues and buttresses prior concepts and ideas. I like the bipartite typology (catchy term), providing a delineation in how we use consciousness and related terms. Is the definition of consciousness resolved... of course not. But I do believe the current article enhances the topic's clarity--i.e., how to properly think about and conceptualize consciousnesses. In this respect, the author has generated at least a modicum of greater semantic lucidity when it comes to this fascinating but deeply complex topic.
