The article addresses the Ben Tre houses, which possess significant historical depth. Rather than being a scientific study, the article generally discusses these houses, their importance, impact on the region, and promotion. Although the authors provide a general introduction to these important houses, they fail to present scientifically rigorous evidence and contributions. Architectural plans, structural element characteristics, and material assessments of the structures are lacking.

Furthermore, the authors mention that the houses face significant structural threats and provide specific recommendations. However, these recommendations represent a general approach and lack scientific evidence. In summary, while the article covers an interesting and unique topic, its scientific foundation is notably weak. I recommend enhancing the article by addressing these aspects.
