Overall, the study topic could add knowledge to the scientific literature. However, there are some changes needed to be made to improve the manuscript to meet the standard of publication. Below are some comments;

Abstract

The abstract should be restructured into Background, Methods and Conclusion.

General aim should be captured as last sentence in background.

The study is about prevalence and you rather recruited only cases, "A sample of 56 cases of Buruli ulcer was identified from the population." then how did the authors compute the prevalence in the statistics?

I have seen in the Results section calculation involving "73,263 x 10,000" where did the authors get this figures?

Prevalence is the proportion of cases to the total participants. You can't talk about prevalence with only cases in your study. Authors are recommended to redone the study topic to add knowledge to the scientific literature.

Conclusion should section be re-written.

Statistical analyses section needs re-written
