

Review of: "Perceptions and Attitudes about COVID-19 Vaccines Regarding Vaccine Intention and Hesitancy of Attendants of a Healthcare Center in Northern Cyprus"

The manuscript reports interesting data regarding vaccine intention and hesitancy among individuals who were present at a health center in Northern Cyprus. However, there are some concerns regarding the study done.

What is the rationale for conducting this study in Northern Cyprus? The absence of such studies in Northern Cyprus does not justify a knowledge gap. In fact, the authors mentioned a similar previous study done in Cyprus (Ref. no. 5). What is/are the reason(s) that this type of studies is required in Northern Cyprus?

There is no justification provided for the sample size of the study. Was it a statistically valid size? Why was a sample size calculation not performed?

Since this study was only on individuals who visited one healthcare center in Northern Cyprus, the findings do not necessarily represent the general perception of Cypriot in Cyprus or even the entire Northern Cyprus region. Care must be used in the discussion and conclusion of this study and the acknowledgement of the limits and confines of the findings must be included.
