## General Comments:

The article provides a comprehensive review of the topic and the use of citations effectively supports the author's viewpoints. But the chosen topic lacks novelty considering the abundance of existing literature. Additionally, the article would benefit from presenting new perspectives or insights, and the author should consider including a broader range of factors in their analysis.

## Specific Comments:

The content of the article is rich, and the citations provide strong support for the author's arguments.

However, given that the COVID-19 pandemic has been ongoing for three and a half years, there is already a plethora of literature on this subject. Consequently, the chosen topic of the article is not novel, as many similar articles have already been published, including in professional reports, popular science articles, and news outlets.

It is evident that this article is a review, as it avoids specific research methods. Although when reaching endemicity for COVID-19 is inherently uncertain, I did not find any quantitative conclusions in the article. After reading the entire article, I did not come across any new perspectives or insights.

Figure 1B illustrates the factors contributing to the transition of COVID-19 from a pandemic to an endemic state. However, it is important to note that there are numerous additional factors to consider, such as human activities, which the author should also address.
