However, the following issues need clarification for further improvement:

- 1. The introduction does not give a enough information about the study to anchor it enough. The authors should explain more about Buruli ulcer and why it is important.
- 2. The authors do not justify the study enough
- 3. The methodology is lacking a lot. In my opinion, the prevalence study should have had a way of counter testing the presence of the lesions, a test for the disease should have complemented.
- 4. The researchers and the respondents did not talk about possible differential diagnoses. The assumption was that all that showed up with the lesions had Buruli ulcer.
- 5. Case definition is also lacking
- 6. The discussion does not bring out the unique circumstances of the study, it just compares with other studies thus denying the reader a very important aspect of the study.
