Thanks to the authors for undertaking this important work. Regarding the procedures and the results, I had some questions. According to the authors, migration can lead to a number of issues, including issues with maternal and reproductive health. It can also have good effects. This should be moved; it belongs in the Introduction section.

The primary research conclusion pertains to the hypothesis that there exists a bivariate correlation between internal migration and mental health status. However, this correlation disappears when other associated factors are taken into account by hierarchical logistic regression. Regression analysis model fit and total explained variance by the model are two more details that should be included. I'd be pleased to read a corrected copy as soon as the writers look into this.

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
